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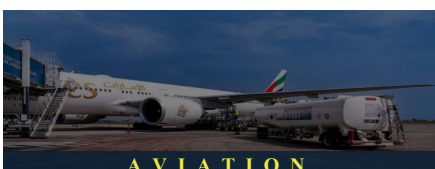
Since its early beginnings, Star Oil Group has been built on a strong conviction: to support the energy development of our countries with diligence, proximity and responsibility.

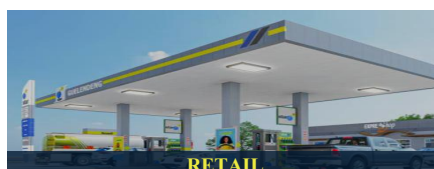

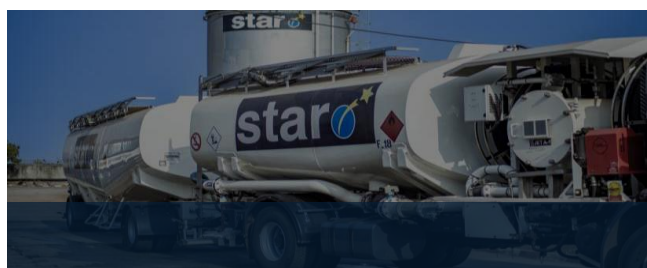

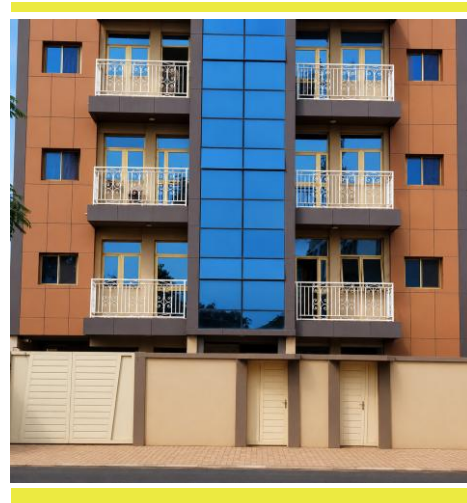
